Curriculum

VLCS students use the Biblically based, individualised, ACE School of Tomorrow® curriculum, by Accelerated Christian Education, Inc., USA – providing for the development of each child’s unique talents and abilities. The curriculum is not grade-locked, allowing students to progress – and succeed – at their own pace (which may also be personalised from subject to subject).

As well as academic studies, students participate in Physical Education, weekly Chapel service, and House Challenge competitions, which include art, music and platform events as well as sports and academic contests. Our students also have opportunity to participate in Local, Regional and International Student Conventions, held every two years. Leadership training and participation in overseas mission ventures are further important components of our investment in our students.

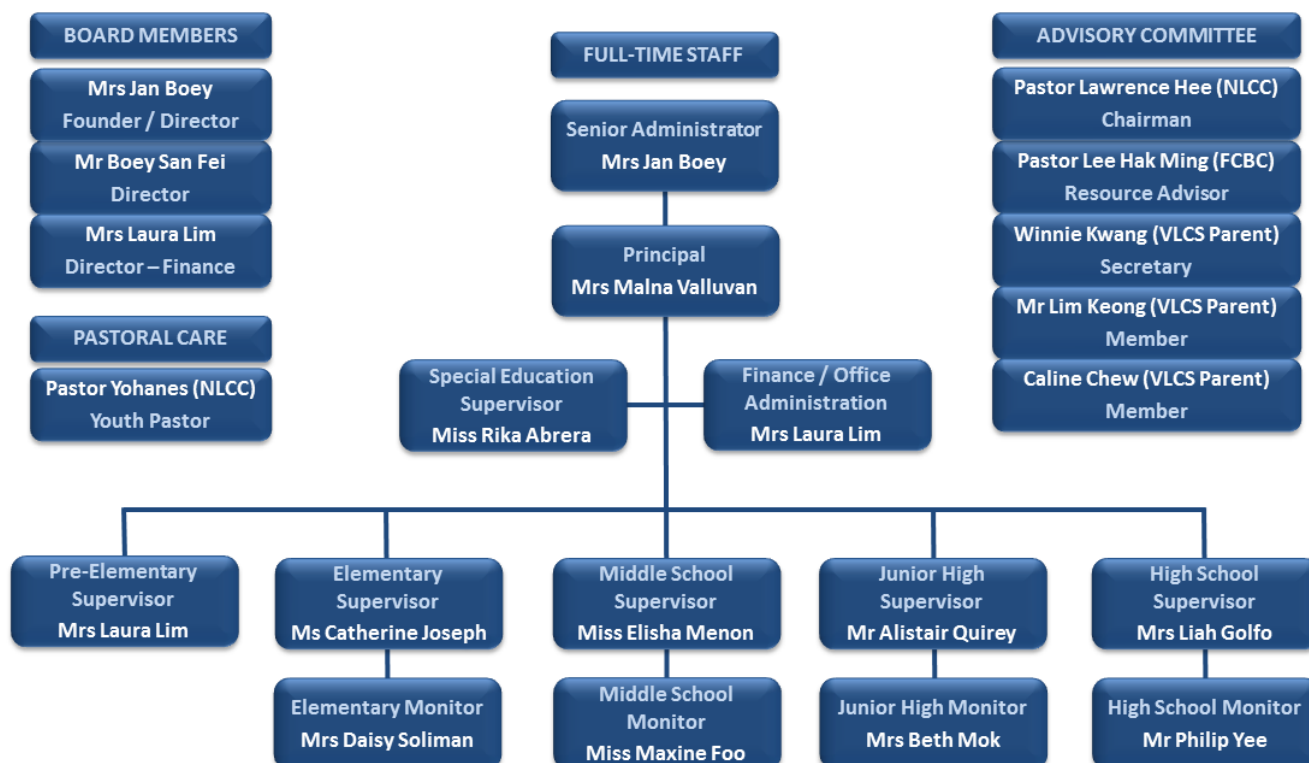
Classes

Facilities

VLCS has a total indoor floor area of 504 m², including staff offices, in-house toilets, conference room, counselling room and multi-purpose hall. We presently have four classrooms (known as Learning Centres, because the ACE® curriculum emphasises learning rather than teaching):
