Praise & Prayer

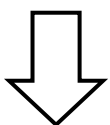

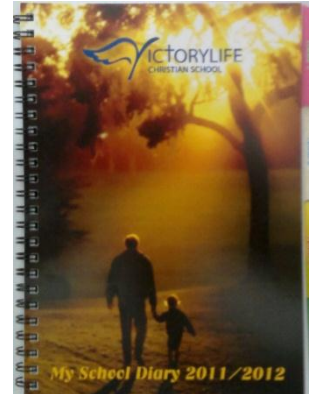

School Diary

We are pleased to announce the release of our first “My School Diary”, now distributed to all students. As well as providing a calendar of events for the next twelve months, and space for daily notes, this diary contains a number of other useful features:



- Our pledges, our school song, the meanings of our flags, and our national shared values.
- Standard of conduct, including punctuality and personal appearance.
- Our discipline and incentives policies.
- NAPFA requirements and targets.
- Goal-setting charts for each term.
- Reminders of the character qualities we'll be focusing on this year.

The daily notes space will be used by students (from Middle School and above) for recording their homework (instead of issuing homework slips) and for noting any announcements. Pre-School and Elementary Class will continue to use homework slips. The diary will also serve as a communication book between supervisors and parents (utilising the daily notes space). Please check your child's diary each day for any homework or other communications.

Very important is the last page - the **Code of Honour Pledge** (replicated on the inside back cover). If you have not already done so, please read through this carefully with your child; then both you and your child are to sign and date both copies. The tear-out page must then be returned to your child's class supervisor.
