Activities for the month of April

Term 4 begins on Monday, 23 March

In following the precautionary measures to combat Covid 19, given by MOE, please be informed of these new processes in the first 2 weeks of the term: (23 March to 3 April).

All students will be ushered by staff to their respective learning centers from 7.15am after temperature screening at the black gate. Students on arrival will not wait in the lobby. Monday's chapel services will be conducted in the respective learning centres. Temperatures will be taken twice a day – when students arrive and after breaks. Housekeeping will be done twice a week (by staff on Wednesdays, and staff and students on Fridays) and more frequently if needed. (All air cons and fans were serviced and staff cleaned and disinfected all surfaces in LCs during the term break last week). All CCAs, ISC trainings and after-school activities will be postponed to the 3rd week of term, i.e. from 6 April. PE will be conducted as usual on Wednesdays for juniors and Fridays for seniors. After school dismissal at 1pm, all students are to leave school for home and stay home. We will keep you informed of any new measures from MOE. Thank you for your understanding and co-operation.
