Activities from 29 June to 31 July

Term 1: Monday 29 June – Friday, 4 September

Students will report to school from 7:30-7:50am. Late-comers will need to call school reception. Please note the following safety and hygiene requirements in line with national advisories for Phase 2:

- 1. All must wear masks, and scan for Safe Entry/Exit at the main entry points of the school. Temperature will be taken by staff before students proceed to their respective learning centers.
- 2. Staff and students will wash hands, clean high-touch surfaces frequently and wipe down tables and shared equipment after use.
- 3. Temperatures will also be taken by staff after their mid-morning breaks. Please be advised that students, staff and visitors who are unwell will be sent home. (If anyone is unwell, or who have household members on Home Quarantine Order/Stay Home Notice or have adult household members with flu-like symptoms such as fever and cough, are required to stay away from school.)
- <u>4.</u> Monday chapel will be conducted in the learning centres. All CCAs and after-school activities will resume at a later date. Intermingling across classes and levels will be reduced.
- 5. All students are to leave school for home after dismissal.

Parents Conference, Monday-Friday, 29 June – 3 July

Students will be dismissed at 12pm. You will be scheduled to meet with your child's supervisor to review your child's progress for Semester 2, 2019-2020. Students must be in full school uniform for the conference. All screening, hygiene and social distancing rules during your visit will be observed.

Youth Day Holiday: Monday, 6 July

As Youth Day falls on Sunday, 5 July, Monday will be a scheduled school holiday.
