- Today is our 15th anniversary – the school was registered on January 17 (in the year 2000), to begin our school mission found in Luke 1:17. We thank God for His faithfulness, His Presence and His Word to prepare a people ready for the Lord since the day of small beginnings up to this day.
- All students made progress last term, in academics and social traits. (2 Tim. 3:16-17)
- All graduates who applied to universities of their choice were admitted. (Jer.29:11)
- School is financially healthy and will be appropriating funds for new premises.
- 37 students copied out Psalm 119 during the school holidays.
- 21 new students registered in January 2015.
- 16 students achieved Honour Roll A.
- 16 students will be sent for International Student Convention in New Mexico.
- 13 high school students will be graduating this year.
- 3 graduates from last year are presently serving as monitors.
- 2 supervisors completed training in November.
- 1 new student received salvation in the first week of this term.
- New PE attire, designed with inputs from the student council.
- ACE Director for Asia will be conducting the supervisors' professional training for the first time in Singapore this March. Parents as well as homeschool parents are encouraged to attend.

Presentation of Honour Roll Certificates – Mrs Valluvan

All sixteen students who achieved Honour Roll last term attained Honour Roll A. Well done!

Requirements for Honour Roll: Complete at least 3 PACEs in each subject. Memorise each month's Bible passage. Pace Test results 88%-93% (Honour Roll B) or 94%-100% (Honour Roll A).
