Student Leaders: (Mr Jonathan) Student leadership training was held at East Coast Park. The student leaders were introduced – for each Learning Centre, Praise & Worship, Media, Library and LSP advocates.

Honour Roll: Certificates were given by the respective supervisors to the parents, who presented them to their children. 46 x Honour Roll A (94%-100%) plus 5 x Honour Roll B (88%-93%) – 23 from Elementary, 8 from Middle School, 7xA + 4xB from Junior High, 8xA + 1xB from High School.

Major Events:

School Spiritual Camp: 26 to 28 October, 2016, at The Girls Brigade, Singapore. Compulsory for all students. Cost \$50 per student. Parents are invited to join us for dinner and the two night sessions. Supervisors will solicit parents to provide “pot bless” dinners.

Supervisors Training: 21 to 25 November, 2016, at VLCS. Open to graduating students as well as parents. Cost \$200 for graduating VLCS students (subsidised by VLCS); \$350 to \$400 for adults.

Community Work: Nineteen students from Senior Learning Centres volunteered for Handicap Welfare Association's flag day on Saturday, 1st October.

International Student Convention: 23 students have indicated their interest to participate in ISC 2017 at Indiana University, Pennsylvania. Students will commence their preparation and begin to raise funds.

Regional Student Convention: Compulsory for all students aged 9 years and above in 2017.

Venue: All-Saints Anglican Academy, Kota Kinabalu, Sabah

Date: late August or early September, 2017
