Staff: The two principals (of the Junior and Senior Learning Centres) introduced their respective Learning Centre staff, including several new staff.

Student Leaders: The student leaders were introduced by Mr Jonathan – for each Learning Centre, Worship, Media, and Library, and LSP advocates.

Honour Roll: Students were presented their Honour Roll awards by their parents. In total, there were 54 Honour Roll A (94%-100%) and 9 Honour Roll B (88%-93%).
