Financial Commitment: Increase in school fees from 2024, and Heartship Fund

By the grace of God, annual school fees have remained the same since 2014. To cover higher operational costs, we appreciate your understanding for the increase in annual school fees by \$600 (or \$50 per month) from 2024.

Annual School fees for 12 years & below: \$9,810 (incl. 9% GST) payable in 6 instalments of \$1,635.

Annual School fees for 13 years & above: \$11,118 (incl. 9% GST) payable in 6 instalments of \$1,853.

Please note that the 1st instalment of school fees for 2024 is due on 15 December 2023.

Currently, we give 20-50% subsidy to 31 students whose parents are financially challenged. We hereby appeal for your generous giving earmarked for Heartship Fund in support of these students. Thank you very much.
