Dear Kingdom parents,

Greetings and thank you for giving priority to conference with staff on your children's growth in faith and their academic progress. We believe many of you are pleased with your child's performance. All glory to God! Thank you for reading and training your children with the Word of God every night. According to Psalm 1, we shall be like trees planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth fruit in season; our leaves also shall not wither; and whatsoever we do shall prosper. Better to spend time reading the Bible as it has been reported that 46.4% of children 15 to 21 have problematic smart phone use (which is stealing, killing and destroying their lives). Let us "fulfil the word of God; and make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory: whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; **that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus**" (Colossians 1:25-28).

More than 5 years ago, when I thanked God for the favour given to our graduates as 100% of them could gain admission into the universities they applied for, He said: "the end of high school is not the pursuit of tertiary education, but to do His good, acceptable and perfect will." Since then, we began focusing on discipling high school students to seek His Kingdom and His righteousness first and foremost, to be transformed by the renewing of their minds with the Word of God, acknowledging their identity in Christ, exercising all that He has given: the spirit of power, love and sound mind, including the power to gain wealth (Deut. 8:18) so that we are blessings to nations. May our students learn trades, be creative, enterprising, and skilful to serve as approved workmen and fulfil the great commission. Amen!

Last weekend, some staff members and 4 student leaders in the Kingdom Council volunteered to serve and bless the underprivileged in Kluang, Johor Bahru. They enjoyed distributing pre-loved clothes, delighted children with face-painting, and healed the sick. This ministry conducts the Feed the Hungry program every Saturday, holds sessions to teach the community farming and other skills, and tutor children in reading and writing English. We hope to enthuse students and parents to regularly volunteer in this ministry.

From 20-23 January, 14 students and 2 staff were invited each day to interact with 40 students from China on a field trip to City Sprouts where education on urban farming is conducted. We commissioned our students to share the love of God to these students. The staff and students fulfilled their mission and enjoyed the field trips. All glory to God!
