Dear Kingdom Parents,
Greetings to all and your family. The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit, be with you all. Amen.

This year's Victory Celebration (VC) is on Friday, 16 October. We look forward to seeing you and your family at VC – do send the attached e-invite to your relatives and friends to come and see God's workmanship in our school.

All our students did their best at both the New Zealand RSC and the SOTAM RSC in Malaysia. In New Zealand, we were greatly blessed to see how students were encouraged to discover their God-given gifts and abilities, learn life skills, develop them, and dedicate their time and energy to the glory of God. We saw that every student was honoured for giving their best at the events they participated in. Student Convention is all about participation – not competition!

From 2027, we want to encourage all students to participate in RSC, and we will endeavour to prepare them not only in sports through CCAs, but also by conducting workshops for story/essay/poetry writing; oratory skills including speech, dramatic dialogue/monologue, storytelling and preaching; radio programming; music/vocals/song composition; acting; puppetry; chess/checkers/Chinese chess; craft including scrapbooking, dressmaking, needle work, crochet, clay sculpture and woodwork; art; photography; website design, PowerPoint presentations, etc. These life skills learnt, and discovery of their God-given gifts and abilities, will help students rise up to their fullest potential and in whatever they do, they will do well as unto the Lord. If parents can volunteer to give some life skill apprenticeship, please let us know. Parents are also most welcome to attend and give moral support at the Student Conventions.

We will soon begin making preparations for the Nov. 2027 ISC in Chiangmai, with discipleship to do the great commission including soul winning (an RSC event), memorization of Scripture: Book of Proverbs (Golden Apple), Book of John (Golden Lamb), Christian Soldier, Scribe (handwrite the whole New Testament), research on herbs, origins of science, farming, new creation in Christ reality, how to know God's will, Bible Bowl, PACE Bowl, etc.

From 2027, we will also implement the family and all-inclusive concept in each Learning Centre, regardless of age and performance level, as each child studies at their individualized pace. This was how we began in the days of small beginnings, and we saw how the stronger and older students related with the weaker/challenged and younger students with love and care for one another.
