Summary of Parents Staff Fellowship (PSF) on Saturday, 13 January 2024

After a time of praise and worship, Mrs. Boey introduced the staff, then supervisors introduced their student leaders, followed by the following messages by Mrs Boey.

Made to make a difference facing forward – Ephesians 2:10

We declare facing forward to a triumphant 2024 in Christ, the knowledge of Him in every place (2 Cor. 2:14, Hab. 2:14, Hos. 4:6) as a people prepared for the Lord (Luke 1:17), awakened to truth (Prov. 3:3), not leaning on our own understanding, acknowledging Him in all our ways (Prov. 3:5-8), setting our affections on things above (1 John 2:15; Col 3:2), our eyes of understanding enlightened (Eph. 1:18), knowing who we are in Christ, a new creation that is not of this world but of God (2 Cor. 5:16-17), blessed with every spiritual blessing (Eph. 1:3-6), that greater is He in us (1 John 4:4), not conforming to the world's system of religion, government, education, family, economics, arts and media, but judging all things (1 Cor 2:15-16), overcoming the world by faith (1 John 5:4), transformed by the renewing of our minds (Rom. 12:1-2), preaching and warning every man (Col. 1:28), as salt (Matt. 5:17) and light (Matt. 5:14), bringing many out of darkness (1 Pet. 2:9), abiding in the Word (John 5:38) Jesus gave us for sanctification (John 17:14-19), proving His good, perfect and acceptable will (Rom. 12:2): Hallowed be Thy Name, Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done in the earth as is done in Heaven... (Matt. 6:9-13). The kingdoms of the world be the Kingdom of the Lord (Rev. 11:15). Jesus' meat is to do the Father's will (John 4:34). Be it unto us according to His Word, His will (Luke 1:38).

Hebrews 5:12-13 For when for the time ye ought to be teachers, ye have need that one teach you again which be the first principles of the oracles of God; and are become such as have need of milk, and not of strong meat. For every one that useth milk is unskilful in the word of righteousness: for he is a babe.

- ▶ Encourage students to do advance work (6-12 pages) daily to ward off social media/AI Chat GPT.
- ▶ Parents please be on the same page with your child in spiritual things, renewing your minds pull down strongholds of conditions/ but be transformed day by day to prove Gods good, perfect, and acceptable will. Discipleship for parents who join the gardening community. Believers are to make disciples and train them to manifest as sons of God. We are facilitating teachings by Curry Blake & Andrew Wommack.
 - 1. Diving Healing Technician *Matthew 10:8* Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.
 - 2. New Man -2 Corinthians 5:17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to Himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. For He hath made Him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in Him.
 - 3. Mind Renewal *Romans 12:1-2* I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.
 - 4. Discipleship Evangelism *Matthew 28:18-20* Jesus spoke to the disciples: All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen.
- ▶ Eden Garden Genesis 1:26-28 And God said, let us make man in our image, after our likeness: and let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, and over the cattle, and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creepeth upon the earth. Gardening club members and parents can also join the community and grow your own food.

Jesus came to establish the Kingdom of God

- ▶ What was message John the Baptist preached?
- ▶ Matthew 4:17: From that time Jesus began to preach, and to say, Repent: for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand. To repent is to have a mindset change! Romans 12:1-2 and 3 John 2
- ▶ Jesus preached many parables to show what the Kingdom is like.
- ▶ He taught us how to pray and declare: His Kingdom come.... *Matthew 6:9-13*
- ▶ He said the world systems will end when the gospel of the Kingdom is preached to the end of the world. *Matthew 24:14*
- Our school mission is to prepare a people to seek His Kingdom and His righteousness first, and overcome the wicked one. Matthew 6:33 and 1 John 2:14

Prioritize seeking God's Kingdom and His righteousness.

Luke 1:45 "And blessed is she that believed: for there shall be a performance of those things which were told her from the Lord." There are many reasons why God's blessings don't always come to pass in a person's life, but the most frequent cause is simply unbelief on our part. There are no limitations on God's part. He is willing and able to do anything He has promised. The problem is with our believing. The Lord has given every believer faith (Rom. 12:3). It was given to us at salvation through hearing the Word of God (Eph. 2:8; Rom. 10:17). It is a fruit of the Holy Spirit (Gal. 5:22). However, we must choose to exercise it. Our faith is linked to our knowledge (2 Pet. 1:1-4). What we think on is how we will be (Pro. 23:7). The problem is not that we don't have faith. The problem occurs when we don't allow our faith to work because we don't keep our minds stayed on God's Word. Then our faith is choked out by the cares of this life (Mk. 4:19). Keeping our minds stayed on God's Word will release our faith and thereby release the power of God in our lives. Certainly, Mary must have been a person who put God's Word first in her life. Mary saw a performance of what she believed. We receive what we believe, not what we desire or even need. Today, believe the word that the Lord has spoken about you. (from Andrew Wommack's Daily Devotional)

- The moment we prioritize God's priorities for our lives first seeking His Kingdom and His righteousness the above ironies of life are immediately set in place: WE FIND PURPOSE IN GOD'S AGENDA, WE KNOW WHAT TO DO BASED ON GOD'S AGENDA, WE BECOME EFFECTIVE BY CONTRIBUTING TO WHAT TRULY MATTERS, AND WE BECOME SUCCESSFUL BY FOCUSING ON THE ASSIGNMENT.
- One of the fundamental keys to success in any field of endeavour is learning God's Kingdom and His righteousness first and then living by them. Any activity that does not fit into or advance any of those priorities is put on the backburner or even cancelled, even if that activity is good in and of itself. Good activities, if they are incompatible with God's established Kingdom priorities, can become distractions that hinder our progress toward success. Our priority is God's Kingdom and His righteousness. Priority is the principal thing upon which we place our primary focus. It is that thing we consider to be of the highest value and worth, first among others. To establish priorities means to rank everything in order of importance and determining which is most important.
 - 1. The importance of purpose highlights the significance of having a clear sense of purpose in one's life. A life without purpose is tragic.
 - 2. Purpose as the source of priority suggests that it is the foundation upon which priorities are built. Without a defined purpose, it is challenging to establish meaningful priorities.
 - 3. The absence of priorities is shown to result in the wastage of time and energy, as individuals may end up doing the wrong thing at the wrong time, leading to inefficiency.
 - 4. People without clear priorities are depicted as spending their time on unnecessary tasks that may not contribute to their overall purpose in life.
 - 5. The absence of priorities can lead to a focus on minor issues rather than the most important aspect of life.
 - 6. Preoccupation with the unimportant and being busy and active without the right priorities may ultimately be ineffective and unproductive.
 - 7. Without clear priorities, individuals may misuse their talents and abilities potentially leading to destructive behaviour and pursuits.
 - 8. Lack of priorities will hinder individuals from understanding and pursuing their life's purpose, leading to a sense of failure and unfulfilment.
 - 9. The absence of priorities results in failure, regardless of how successful one may appear in their pursuits. Priorities are seen as essential for directing one's life effectively.
- ▶ MISPLACED PRIORITIES: MEETING PERSONAL NEEDS. Priority of man's dominion: From the beginning of human creation, God established the priority of man's dominion over the earth. This mandate was focused on kingdom rulership, stewardship, and governance. *Genesis* 1:26-28; Isaiah 9:6; 1 Peter 2:9; Revelation 1:6

God's instructions for Kingdom parents

▶ God's instructions for parents: *Deuteronomy 6:4-9*

- ▶ Redeem the time: Parents, please read the Word of God with your children every night following the Bible reading schedule. Discuss and help your children understand God's Word. Do not be wary that children cannot understand, for the Word of God gives understanding to the simple. *Psalms 119:130* And the Word of God brings healing to the bones and to the flesh. *Proverbs 4:21*
- ▶ Beware the god of this world who is devouring children through wars, AI chat GPT, social media, LGBTQ, gaming, paedophilia, racism, tares sown by the enemy, climate hoax, deception, false purpose, false teachers, etc.
- ▶ Suffer the children to come to Jesus for they belong to the Kingdom of Heaven, here on earth. Our mission is to prepare a people ready for Him, not for the world.
- ▶ Be on the same page with your children viewing and learning from DE, DHT, NM, MR. We are offering discipleship sessions on Saturday afternoons.
